2                   **SUPPORTING NET NEUTRALITY LEGISLATION**

3   **WHEREAS**, the growth of a free and open internet has provided historic advances in the realms  
4 of communication, research and economic development; and

5   **WHEREAS**, to encourage broadband deployment and preserve and promote the open and  
6 interconnected nature of the internet, California consumers are entitled to access the lawful  
7 internet content of their choice without interference by their internet service providers; and

8   **WHEREAS**, to encourage the transformation of California's economy to meet future needs and  
9 to further the growth of California's technology industry, California businesses are entitled to,  
10 and require, open and unfettered internet access;

11 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Sonoma County Democratic Central Committee  
12 supports passage of net neutrality legislation in California and at the Federal level, and calls  
13 upon the California Democratic Party to adopt a position in favor of Net Neutrality; and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Sonoma County Democratic Central Committee  
15 distribute copies of this resolution to Senators Feinstein and Boxer, members of the US House  
16 of Representatives, California Senate, and California Assembly representing Sonoma County,  
17 to such media outlets as the Public Relations Committee may deem appropriate; and to all other  
18 California county Democratic central committees and to the California Democratic Party for  
19 consideration and support.
